Peach has played with the likes of Paul Barrere (Little Feat), Joey Delgado (Delgado Brothers), Marty Grebb (The Buckinghams), Garth Hudson (The Band) Reggie McBride (Elton John), and Taj Mahal. Interestingly, she has even played with Condoleezza Rice. The National Security Adviser was once Peach's accompanist. "She was on her way to being a great starving musician," Peach smiles.



Peach's performance in the HOB's Voodoo Lounge will also include her backing band the Blues All-Stars. The group currently consists of bassist Will MacGregor (Chuck Berry), guitarist Josh Sklair (Etta James), keyboardist Ken Stange (Joe Cocker), and drummer Tom Walsh (Spyro Gyra).

House of Blues on Sunday, January 12 at 7 p.m. If previous performances are any indication, Peach and the Blues All-Stars will provide music fans with some spontaneous, memorable musical moments as she performs not only old school blues but more contemporary cuts as well.
